





City of West Des Moines - Engineering Services Notice of 60th Street Concrete Patching and Asphalt Resurfacing

Location: 60th Street from Westown Parkway to University Ave

Estimated duration: 5-6 Weeks

Wednesday, September 8th at 7am, Des Moines Asphalt and Paving will be fully closing the first section of 60th street for concrete patch work. This section (stage 1) will be in the northbound lanes only between Westown Pkwy and 59th Place and is expected to last 3-5 days. The concrete patching will be split into four different sections along 60th St. from Westown Pkwy to University Ave each lasting 3-5 days. 59th Place & 60th St. intersection will remain open to east and west bound traffic as shown on the map. Detours will be set in place to accommodate each section of closing. Please see the attached map showing the 4 stages of concrete patching and detour route.

The contractor will clean up the debris and backfill with the dirt available. When they return to perform turf restoration, they will place black compost dirt and seed the small disturbed area behind the back of curb.

Soon after the contractor completes patching, then they will close 60th Street down completely and pave the surface section from curb to curb for the entire length of the project. This will likely occur on a Saturday and Sunday in early/mid-October. They will start early that morning and will go into late afternoon or early evening depending on how fast the asphalt cools so they can paint the traffic striping lines.

At a later date, they will redo all of the handicap ramps at the intersections. This work causes minimal disruptions to the traveling public or the property owners. Also concrete boxouts will be poured around the manholes at a later date but they will utilize short lane closures to do the work so everyone can still get through with little disruptions.

West Des Moines Emergency Services will be notified of the road closures.
